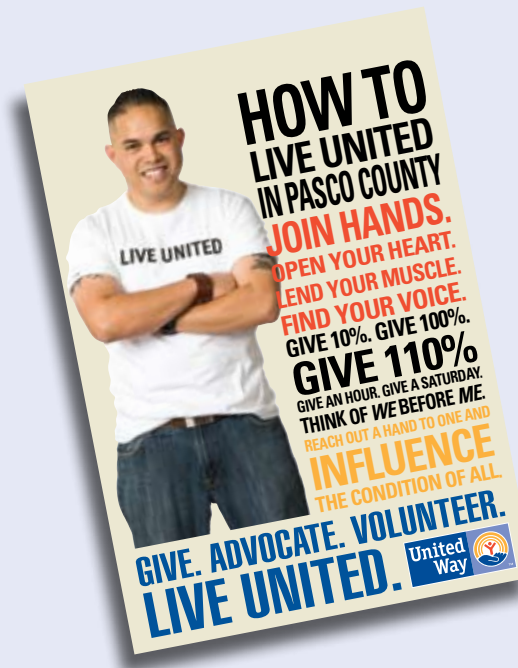
Advancing the COMMON GOOD

We invite you to be a part of the change. Together, united, we can inspire hope and create opportunities for a better tomorrow.

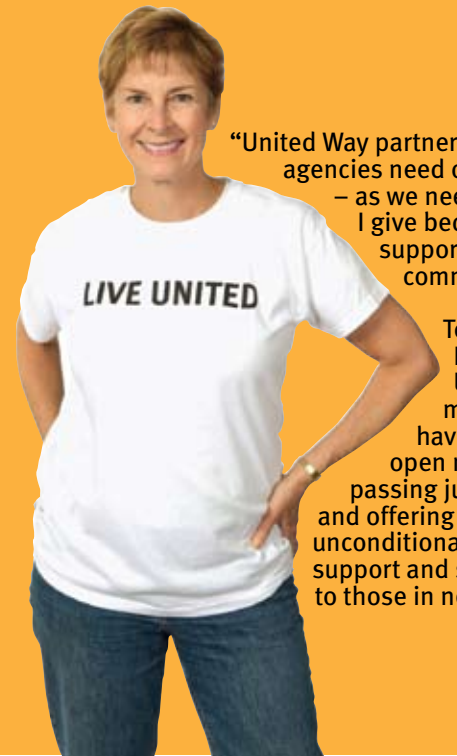
